Tell us about your claim

At this point, you'll only need to provide basic information – your name, policy details and the nature of your claim. One of our claims specialists will arrange to call you back to progress your claim.



We'll be in touch

We'll contact you at the time arranged to collect all the details we need. This includes any medical information, such as copies of any letters you've received from your consultant. Most customers prefer to do this bit over the telephone (it's quicker and more personal), but we can also send a claim form by post.

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Assessing your claim

After this call, or once we have received a completed claim form, your claims specialist will collect **any other information required** to assess the claim. This could include information from your **GP**, your consultant or an independent medical specialist. We'll keep you up to speed by phone, email or text (whichever you prefer).



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Claim payment

Once a claim is accepted, we will arrange **electronic payment** into your bank account.
